Booster Station Update

Update on the booster station project. Our new Booster Pump Station (BPS) project is nearing its end. Within a week or two the BPS will be online serving the community. What does this mean for you? If you live on Tottenham or to the west of Tottenham and north of Londonderry you will see an increase in pressure. This area is considered the high-pressure zone with a top discharge pressure of 85 psi, therefore an increase of about 20 PSI. Ensure your reducing valves are set to regulate this additional pressure. Most homes are rated somewhere from 120-150. The rest of the community will remain at 63 psi and therefore not see any increase in pressure. The new BPS will be able to delivery higher flow and therefore will be able to handle high demand times more efficiently. We will also have an open house around April for anyone that is interested to come and see the BPS first hand.



Kid's Corner: Candy Robot Valentine

Materials Needed

- Large Box Conversation Hearts
- Small Box Conversation Hearts
- Reeses Mini Peanut Butter Cups
- Individually Wrapped Kit Kats
- Hershey's Kisses
- Dove or Hershey's Heart Shaped Chocolates
- Pink or Red Scrapbook Paper
- Hot Glue Gun + Glue sticks

Instructions

- Step 1: Cover the two candy boxes with cute scrapbook paper.
- Step 2: Use hot glue to attach two heart eyes to the smaller box and Hershey Kiss ears to each side.
- Step 3: The large candy box will be the robot's body. Glue a Reeses cup to the top of the large box and attach that to the small box. This piece is the neck.
- Step 4: Glue candy arms to each side of the robot.
- Step 5: Stack three Reeses together to make a leg, then repeat for the second leg, then attach those to the bottom of the large box.
- Step 6: Finish off the robot with a heart shaped candy on the chest area.
